Format:

All assignments should be done according to the following format:

- Assignment must have a cover page including *title of assignment, subject, date of submission, students name, class, roll no. and submitted to.*

- Pages should be numbered.
- Mention **Contents** at the beginning and **References** at the end of the assignment.
- The assignment should be written in **MS-Word** only with extension .doc (not .docx).
- Font should be **Times New Roman** with size **12**.
- Headings should be **Bold** with size **16** and sub-headings should be **Bold** with size **14**.
- Alignment should be **Justified**.
- Line spacing should be **1.5 lines**.
- Page size should be **A4** and margins should be Left-Right = 0.75 inch and Top-Bottom = 1 inch.
- The questions should be **Bold** and one blank line must be there after each answer.
- **No colors** should be used except for diagrams. Text should be in black color only.
- Your assignment should be according to the above said instructions otherwise it will be rejected.
